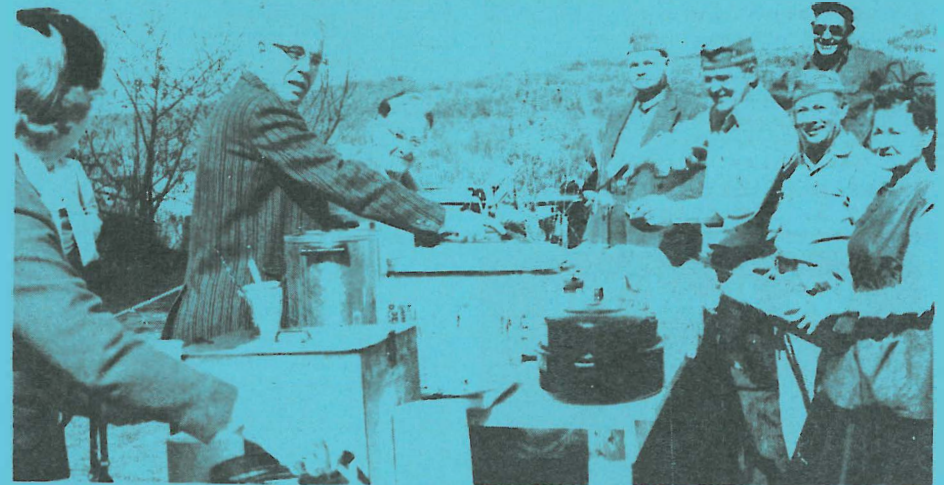

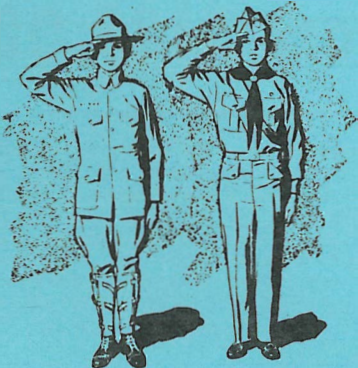

EGG RANCH MOVES

All chicken equipment is being moved from the Stiehm place, 2405 Tavern Road, following a sale involving trades of this 5½ acres and home for \$45,000. on a townsite on Hwy 80 at the junction of Hwy 94, now known as Boulevard, the postoffice having recently been moved 2.2 miles west. Sale price was \$120,000 for the 83 acres including new postoffice, cafe, 19-unit motel, trailer park and court house.

The Farrell Stiehms have already moved with their 11 children and are operating Happy Hens Egg Ranch from there, where the children are now attending Mt. Empire schools. Bob Mack, their foreman, moved also.

Buyer of the choice property, corner of Tavern and South Grade Roads, is John Twyman, business property specialist and pioneer realtor of La Mesa. He is a retired chief warrant carpenter of the navy. With his wife Doris, he bought this for future development.

He brought the Food Basket Anthony Department Store, Bank of America, U.S. National Bank, State MVD Dept., and other large organizations into the LM area, also sold the Rose Hedge Manor last year. He remodeled the Oak Knolls place which Stiehm bought, making it one of the fine

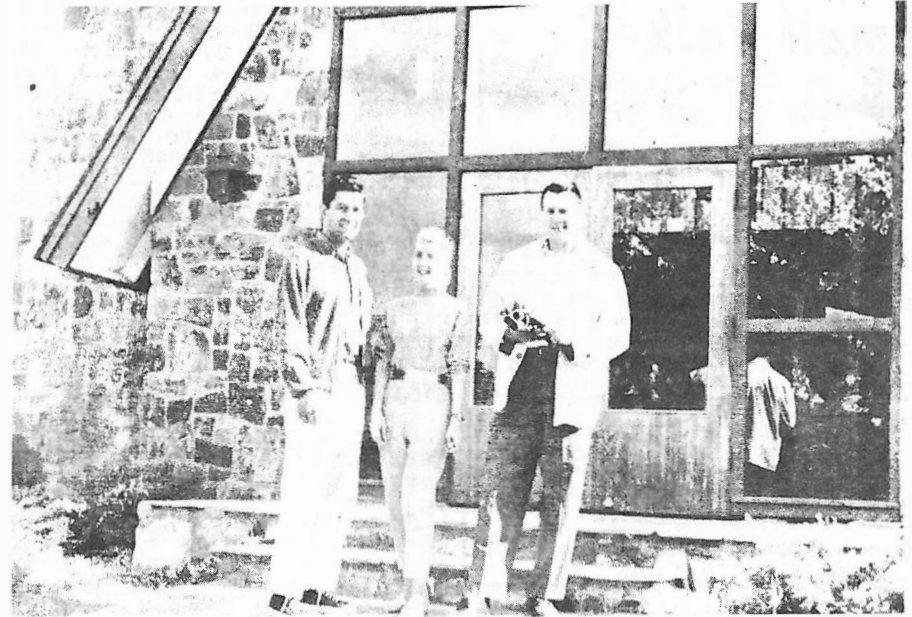
RONNIE ROOKLIDGE WEDS

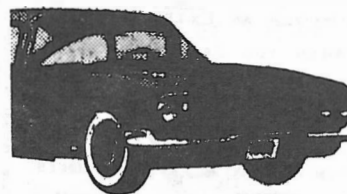

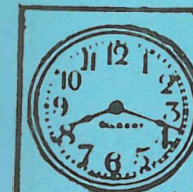

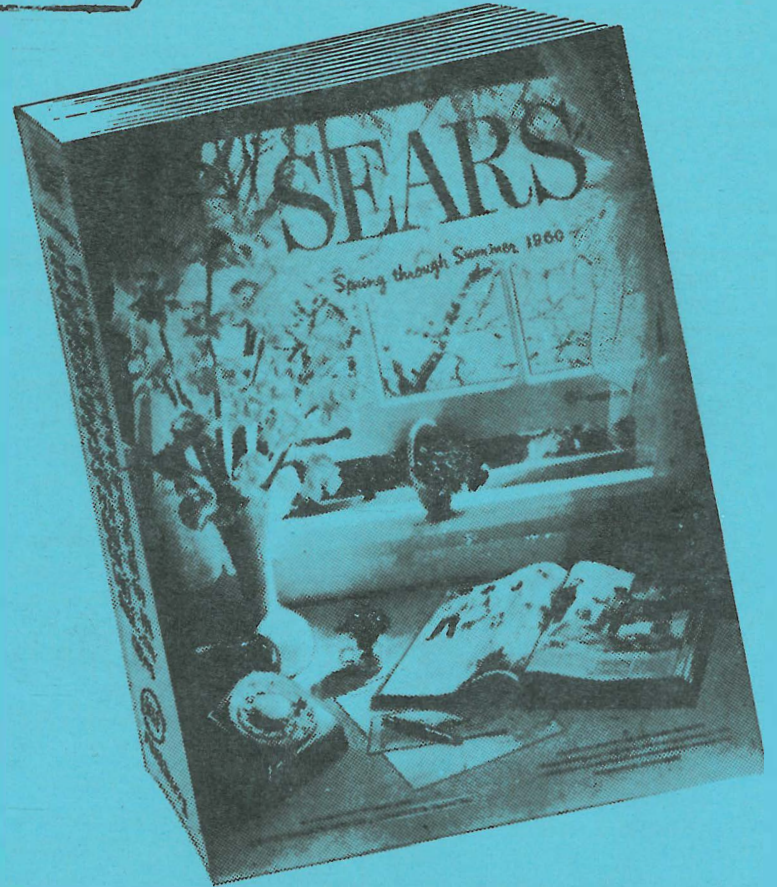
