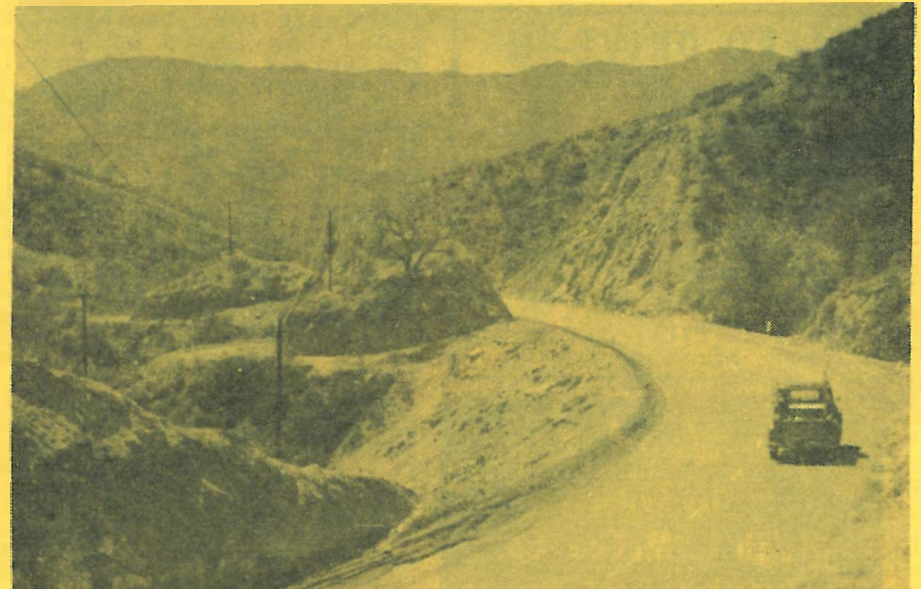

Worldwide focus on the Chessman death controversy has, to the impassioned, analytical mind, brought much serious thought. The legal, mob psychology, the thirst for blood, and the calm sentiment for mercy of others reveals some ugly and beautiful facets of mankind.

As a Christian nation professing to be followers of the forgiving Jesus, it seems that we are woefully strong for vengeance, even in face of the unusual, cruel and perverted punishment the victim has already suffered during nearly 12 years in that sanity breaking death row, facing eight agonizing times of seeing the grisly gas chamber only a few hours away.

Dozens of innocent men have been executed, only to have been found innocent after it was too late to give them their freedom. To anyone that has read Chessman's first two books, 'Cell 2455, Death Row' and 'The Face of Justice', he will regard the case differently and with the possibility that he is really not the sex terrorist.

Capital punishment is abhorrent to the civilized, peaceful, Christian. When it is carried through as hanging, the electric chair and now the blood chilling gas chamber, it reeks of sadism, nearly as cold and cruel as tortures of the dark ages.

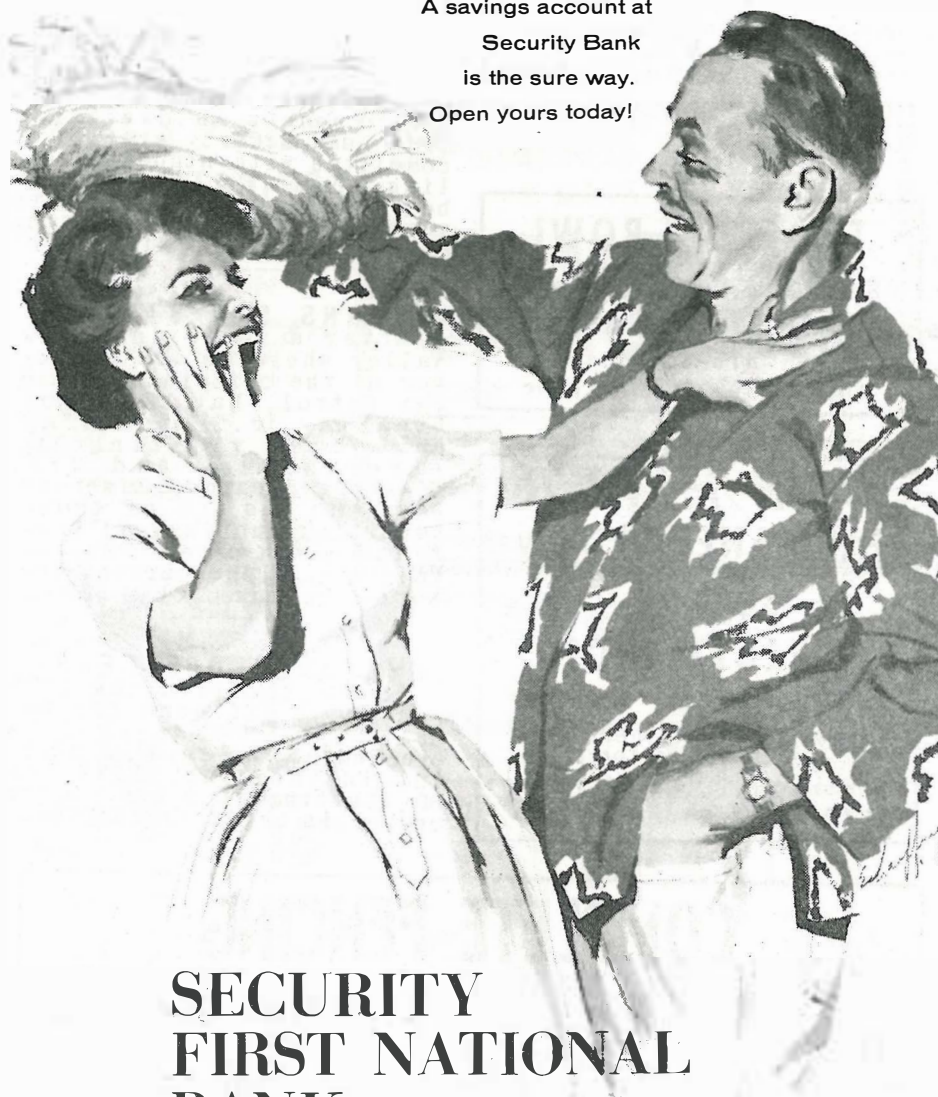
The death penalty has not stopped murder. In this area two dastardly crimes, rape

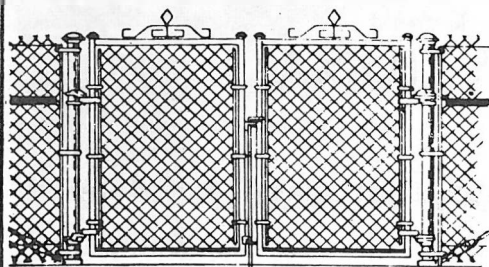

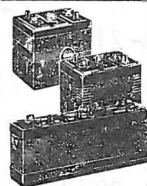

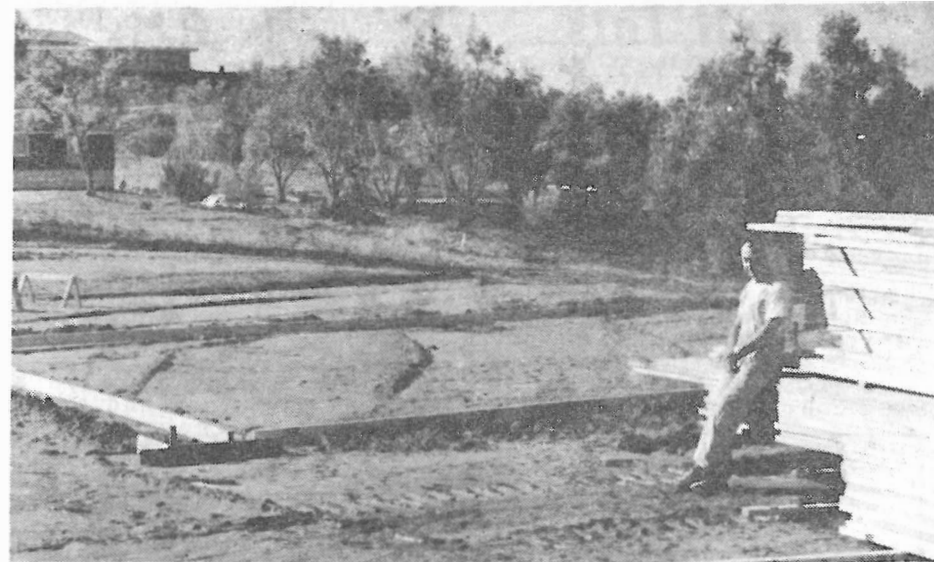
An Alpine young lady and a former Alpine youth are

and brutal murder of an 11-year old girl and a 70-year old woman were recently committed. Many other killings have been done and there is no letup in sight.

Perhaps the most unfair point is the attitude on the reprieve granted by Gov. Brown partly because of S. American sentiment and possible harm, or demonstrations on President Eisenhower. Another is the political aspect where Republican politicians and press condemn Brown, thus stimulating the blood-thirsty ones. The Governor has been on the spot and his opponents have jumped at this case to damage him. Before Execution Friday his poll was 2 to 1 for life, but now it is opposite.

We believe the State Supreme Court should change its vote from 4 to 3, so Gov. Brown might commute the sentence to life imprisonment, for should it be proved that Chessman is not guilty, California and the US would feel a lot better. Just why is the law so opposed to giving him a lie detector test anyhow? (Sun for 10-23-59 & 1-22-60). -CI
