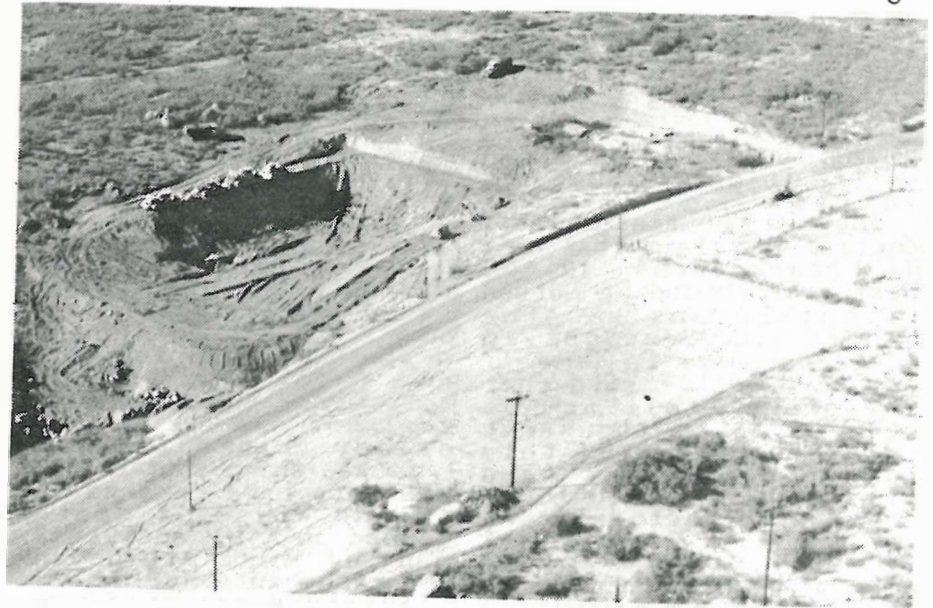

EDITORIAL



50,000 Lives a Year Lost to Suicide!

The 10th most unwanted killer in the US today is suicide!

That is the statement of doctors who claim that half of these deaths, 19,500 last year, could be halved if physicians and the public only recognized danger signals in time to give aid. It is said that the annual toll may be even 50 to 60 thousand!

Three fourths of this huge toll is men, said Dr. P.I. Robinson of N.Y. City, at a doctors' convention in Denver. 'A

large percentage of victims are socially desirable, worthwhile individuals' he said.

It is agreed that mental depression is the main springboard to self-destruction, but many are preventable if signs of depression are recognized and treated. These are insomnia, loss of weight, tensions and agitation, or any change in mood.

It was shown that college students have that as the second cause of death, topped only by accidents, many of which may be unconscious suicidal drives.

Suicides are more preventable than many other major causes of death and the public should be educated to accept psychiatric care, and to know that the recovery rate from all types of depression is excellent.

One sure way to prevent these tensions and inclinations toward self-destruction, is to lead simple, healthful life, through right diet, exercise and a will to live properly.

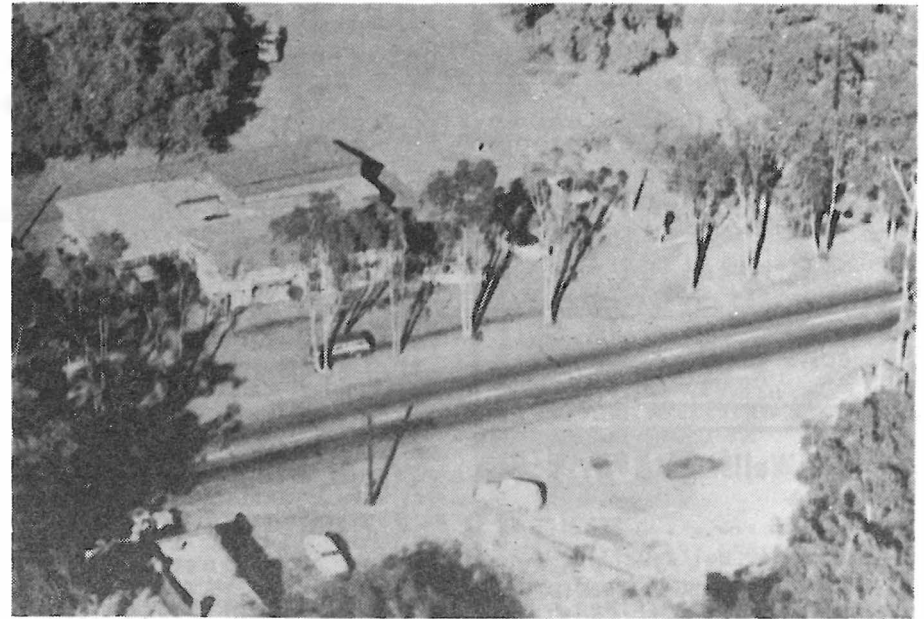
ANTIQUe SHOP IS LEASeD

The survey which started in 1959 as part of a national cancer quiz, is headed this year by Mrs. Chas. Decker, research chairman for the EC area. It queries 1.2 millions in the US to determine relationship of one's living habits to the disease. They are contacted every two years.

'This time we are asking them if they work or live in smog areas' says Mrs. Decker, 'and what brand and how many cigarettes they use daily. A strong youth program on smoking and cancer is being put on'.

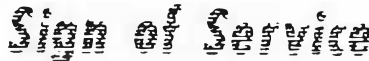
